

### Directions

#### **From Roanoke, VA: ( Approx. 1 hour, 20 minutes by car)**

220 South to 58 West (at Martinsville); Follow 58 approx. 25 miles to Stuart. Take first Stuart exit (on left). (Follow the Hardee's signs.) Left at stoplight onto Rt. 8 S. Left (at 2nd light facing Rite-aid) onto Rt. 8 S. Go approx 2 miles. Patrick County High School is on right.

#### **From Greensboro, NC: (Approx. 1 hour, 20 minutes by car)**

220 North to 58 West (at Martinsville); Follow 58 approx. 25 miles to Stuart. Take first Stuart exit (on left). (Follow the Hardee's signs.) Left at stoplight onto Rt. 8 S. Left (at 2nd light facing Rite-aid) onto Rt. 8 S. Go approx 2 miles. Patrick County High School is on right.

#### **From Charlotte, NC: (Approx. 2 hours by car)**

77 North to Rt. 89 (exit 100). Stay on 89 through Mt. Airy until it runs into 103 East. Follow 103 approx. 25 miles to a dead end. Left on Rt. 8 N. Follow Rt. 8 North ~4 miles. PCHS on left.

#### **From Wytheville: (Approx. 1 hour, 15 minutes by car)**

77 South to 58 East. Follow 58 East approx 50 miles. Take second Stuart exit (to Rt. 8 S). At stop sign, turn left onto 58 E (business). Follow 58 to stoplight at Exxon gas station. Right onto Rt. 8 S. At 2nd light make left (light faces Rite-aid) on Rt. 8 S. Go approx 2 miles. PCHS on rt.

#### **From Lynchburg, VA: (Approx. 2 hours by car)**

29 South to 57 W at Chatham (right). 57 West to 220 S at Martinsville (right). 220 South to 58 West (right). Go approx 25 miles to Stuart. Take the first Stuart exit (on left). (Follow the Hardee's signs.) Left at stoplight onto Rt. 8 S. Left (at 2nd light facing Rite-aid) onto Rt. 8 S. Go approx 2 miles. Patrick County High School is on right.

#### **From Winston-Salem, NC: (Approximately 1 hour by car)**

Take 52 North to Rt. 8 North (Germanton Road). Follow Rt. 8 North signs approximately 50 miles. Before you get to Stuart, look for Patrick County High School on your left.

#### **From Galax, VA: (Approximately 1 hour by car)**

Follow 58 East approx 50 miles. Take second Stuart exit (to Rt. 8 S). At stop sign, turn left onto 58 E (business). Follow 58 to stoplight at Exxon gas station. Right onto Rt. 8 S. At 2nd light make left (light faces Rite-aid) on Rt. 8 S. Go approx 2 miles. PCHS on rt.

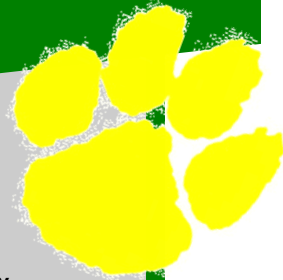

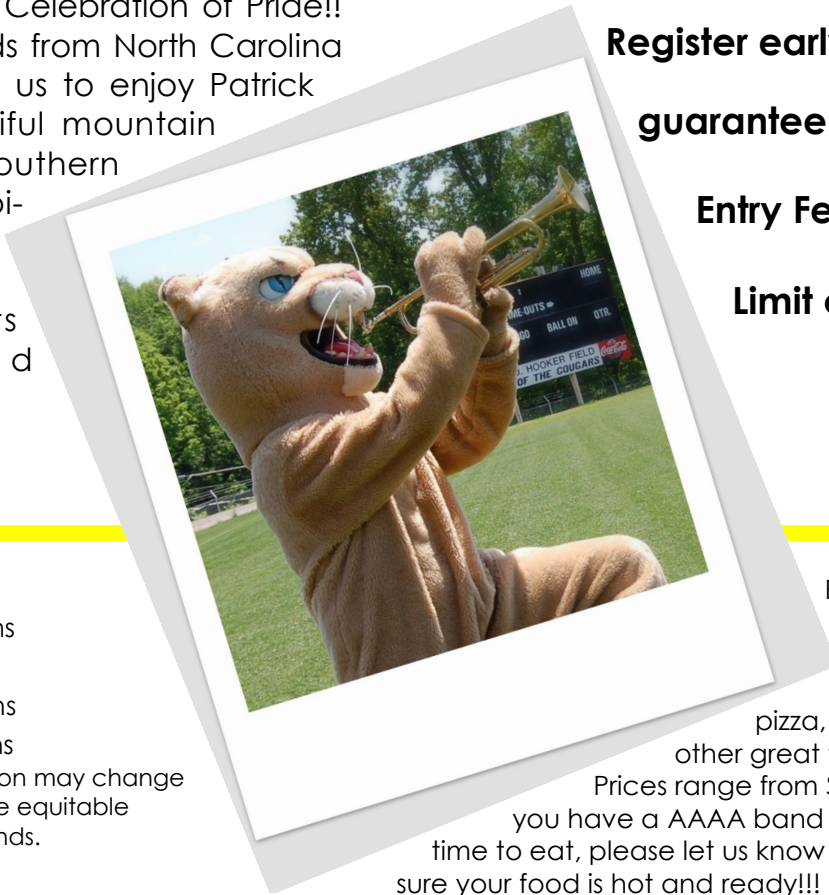
